A Concept Note: Sanskrit Lexicography has been considered as an important facet of Indian Intellectual Tradition. The culture of this branch started in India at about 7th century B.C.E. with the compilation of निघण्टु. It is a compilation of Vedic words. In classical Sanskrit the culture of this branch though started with a few non-extant pre-Amarakośa lexicons but the surge of study started with the compilation of Amarakośa, its commentaries and a large number of post-Amarakośa lexicons like शाश्वत, मेदिनी etc. Even after these the lexicons like शब्दकल्पद्रुम, वाचस्पत्यम् make this tradition vibrant. The forth-coming Seminar will expose the glory of this intellectual tradition.
